ETP Cleanliness and Its Importance in the Swachhta Drive

The Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) is vital for treating hospital wastewater before it is released, ensuring protection of both the environment and community health. A clean and well-maintained ETP prevents foul odor, mosquito breeding, and accidental contamination, while also keeping the hospital compliant with biomedical waste and pollution control standards. In this way, ETP cleanliness directly supports the goals of the Swachhta Drive.

To keep the ETP functioning safely and effectively, the following areas were closely monitored during the Swacchta Drive:.

General Area Cleanliness - surroundings made free from litter, dust, stagnant water, and foul odor.

Equipment & Tanks – tanks, pipelines, and filters inspected to be intact, without leakage, sludge overflow, or blockages.

Wastewater Flow – inlet and outlet channels inspected to be clear; treated water should appear clean and without contaminants.

Sludge & Solid Waste – sludge monitored to be collected and disposed of safely, without accumulation near the plant.

Vector & Pest Control – no mosquito breeding or rodent activity observed; spraying was also carried out.

Staff Safety & Hygiene – workers encouraged to use PPE (gloves, boots, masks).

Documentation & Records – daily cleaning logs and treatment records OLMS maintained.
