REPORT OF 12th AUGUST ACTIVITY

Chacha Nehru Bal Chikitsalaya (CNBC) recognizes the control of Hospital-Associated Infections (HCAI) as a critical issue and is committed to ensuring that appropriate safeguards are implemented to identify, prevent, and manage infections. All hospital functions are included in this endeavor.

Infection Control at CNBC involves the prevention and management of infections through the application of research-based knowledge in areas such as standard precautions, decontamination, waste management, surveillance, and audits.

The overarching aim of this programme is to provide evidence-based information to support infection prevention and control across the hospital. To achieve this aim, a dedicated **Hospital Infection Control Committee (HICC)** has been established. This committee is responsible for overseeing all infection control activities and ensuring compliance with both legal and professional standards. This initiative is relevant to all hospital staff—including doctors, nurses, clinical professionals, and managers—to help them fulfill their responsibilities in controlling communicable diseases and maintaining hygiene.

Activities Conducted on 12th August 2025 as part of the Swachhata Drive:

1. A **Hospital Infection Control Committee (HICC)** meeting was held under the chairpersonship of **Worthy Director Dr. Seema Kapoor**. All HIC members were present and actively participated.
2. **Key Performance Indicators (KPIs)** related to infection control were thoroughly reviewed and discussed.
3. All **healthcare-associated infection (HCAI)** issues were examined in detail, including **root cause analysis** of reported cases and corrective and preventive actions were suggested.
4. Routine HIC activities were carried out with **special emphasis on the Swachhata Drive**, reinforcing the importance of cleanliness and hygiene in infection prevention.
5. Efforts and initiatives taken by various departments were **appreciated and acknowledged**.
6. The **Hospital Infection Control Manual** was reviewed and updated as needed.
7. **Infection Control Champions** were identified and **recognized for their outstanding contribution** to promoting best practices in infection control.


CIRCULAR

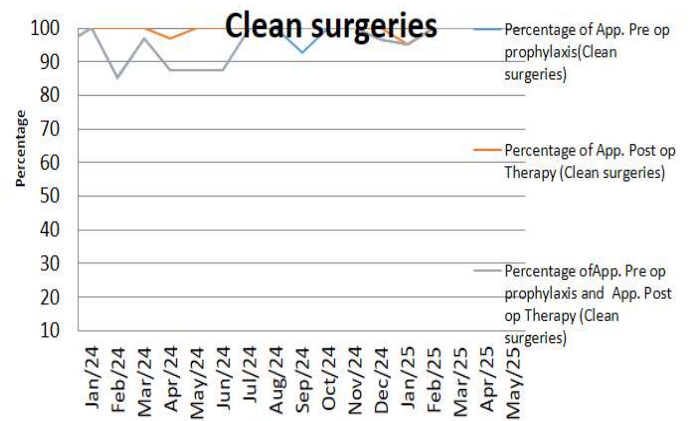
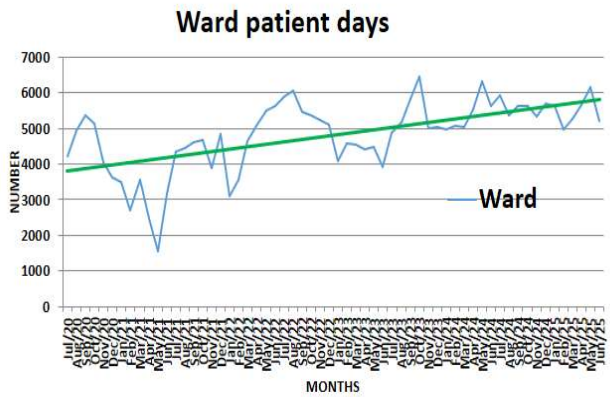
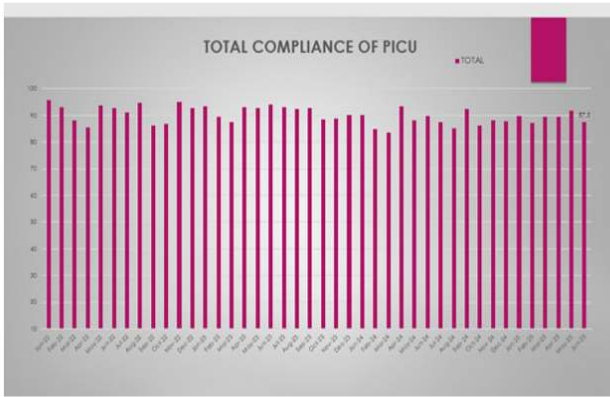
