Clean and safe water is very important for any place. So water testing and cleaning of reservoirs like tanks play an important role in ensuring safe and clean drinking water. So water testing in hospital is not just a regulatory formality -it is life saving practice. 1. All water tanks cleaning schedule is already there. Water tank cleaning was done.
2. Monthly biochemical and microbiological testing of water is already being done .In continuation with same practices water was collected at source at one point for testing.
3. Monthly RO tank maintenance is done by a checklist and record is maintained. Today RO maintenance was done.
4. Waste to wonder activity was conducted in different wards. DPCC class for e- waste management was also conducted.
