




BACKGROUND

As we enter the 16th day of the initiative inspired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's vision of #ViksitBharat2047 and the Swachh Bharat Mission, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Delhi, Smt. REPORT OF 16thAUGUST ACTIVITY

The "SHRAMDAAN" outside the workplace created a cleaner and healthier environment for the community and strengthened the hospital's role in promoting public health. It extends the impact of cleanliness beyond hospital premises and encourages Team work and staff participation in community hygiene improvement. It inspires nearby communities to participate in SWACHHHTA DRIVE and reduce the risk of diseases by removing garbage, stagnant water, and waste from community areas.

Mosquito Breeding check prevents the spread of vector borne diseases and early detection of breeding spots which improves the overall hospital hygiene and safety. Drainage, stagnant water and vector check keeps surroundings hygienic free from water borne diseases risk and ensure compliance with public health and hospital infection control standards.
