




BACKGROUND

Toilet fixture and tap functionality;


Background: Toilets are elementary need of every person in hospital and society. Various activities planned ensuring hygiene and functionality through regular inspection of toilet fixture and taps.

- 2. All toilet seats checked and repaired by PWD civil.




